Why?? **HYDROCEPHALUS**

Children are our most fragile patient and #1 priority
East Africa has high incidence: 14.000 cases per year
And only...

18 neurosurgeons per 100.000.000 habitantes
Shunts in Africa?

Invariably **MUST** be purchased by patient
Cost is equal to a **MONTHS** salary
Availability **UNCERTAIN**
Long. term shunt dependency is **DANGEROUS**

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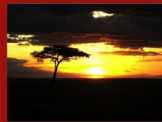
